Executive Demographic Summary Report

Population

The current year population in this selected geography is 353,895. The 2000 Census revealed a population of 332,807, and in 1990 it was 291,478 representing a 14.2% change. It is estimated that the population in this area will be 364,280 in 2013, representing a change of 2.9% from 2008. The current population is 49.0% male and 51.0% female. In 2008, the median age of the population in this area was 35.3, compared to the US median age which was 36.9. The population density in your area is 752.6 people per square mile.

Households

There are currently 128,593 households in this selected geography. The Census revealed household counts of 123,082 in 2000, up from 104,534 in 1990, representing a change of 17.7%. It is estimated that the number of households in this area will be 130,932 in 2013, representing a change of 1.8% from the current year. For the current year, the average household size in this area is 2.75 persons.

In 2008, the median number of years in residence in this geography's population is 4.12. The average household size in this geography was 2.67 people and the average family size was 3.32 people. The average number of vehicles per household in this geography was 2.0.

Income

In 2008, the median household income in this selected geography was \$60,426, compared to the US median which was \$52,599. The Census revealed median household incomes of \$48,121 in 2000 and \$32,449 in 1990 representing a change of 48.3%. It is estimated that the median household income in this area will be \$67,541 in 2013, which would represent a change of 11.8% from the current year.

In 2008, the per capita income in this area was \$24,235, compared to the \$US per capita, which was \$26,464. The 2008 average household income for this area was \$65,100, compared to the US average which was \$68,953.

Race & Ethnicity

In 2008, the racial makeup of this selected area was as follows: 88.5% White; 7.2% Black; 0.1% Native American; 2.2% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 0.7% Other. Compare these to the US racial makeup which was: 73.5% White, 12.4% Black, 0.8% Native American, 4.6% Asian/Pacific Islander and 5.7% Other.

People of Hispanic ethnicity are counted independently of race. People of Hispanic origin make up 2.6% of the current year population in this selected area. Compare this to the US makeup of 15.5%. Changes in the population within each race and ethnicity category from the 1990 Census to the 2000 Census are as follows: 83.3% American Indian, Eskimo, Aleut Population; 98.1% Asian, Pacific Islander; 33.5% Black; 225.0% Hispanic Ethnicity; 397.8% Other; White 10.4%.

Housing

The median housing value in this area was \$72,894 in 1990, compare this to the US median of \$78,382 for the same year. The 2000 Census median housing value was \$118,434, which is a 62.5% change from 1990. In 1990, there were 72,366 owner occupied housing units in this area vs. 88,083 in 2000. Also in 1990, there were 32,168 renter occupied housing units in this area vs. 34,999 in 2000. The average rent in 1990 was \$325 vs. \$478 in 2000.

Employment

In 2008, there were 187,635 people over the age of 16 in the labor force in your geography. Of these 93.3% were employed, 6.6% were unemployed, 32.2% were not in the labor force and 0.1% were in the Armed Forces. In 1990, unemployment in this area was 5.3% and in 2000 it was 4.0%.

In 2008, there were 164,940 employees in this selected area (daytime population) and there were 11,547 establishments. For this area in 1990, 58.8% of employees were employed in white-collar occupations and 41.2% were employed in blue-collar occupations. In 2000, white collar workers made up 60.9% of the population, and those employed in blue collar occupations made up 39.1%. In 1990, the average time traveled to work was 12 minutes and in 2000 it was 21 minutes.
